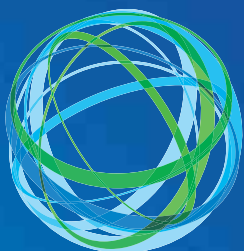

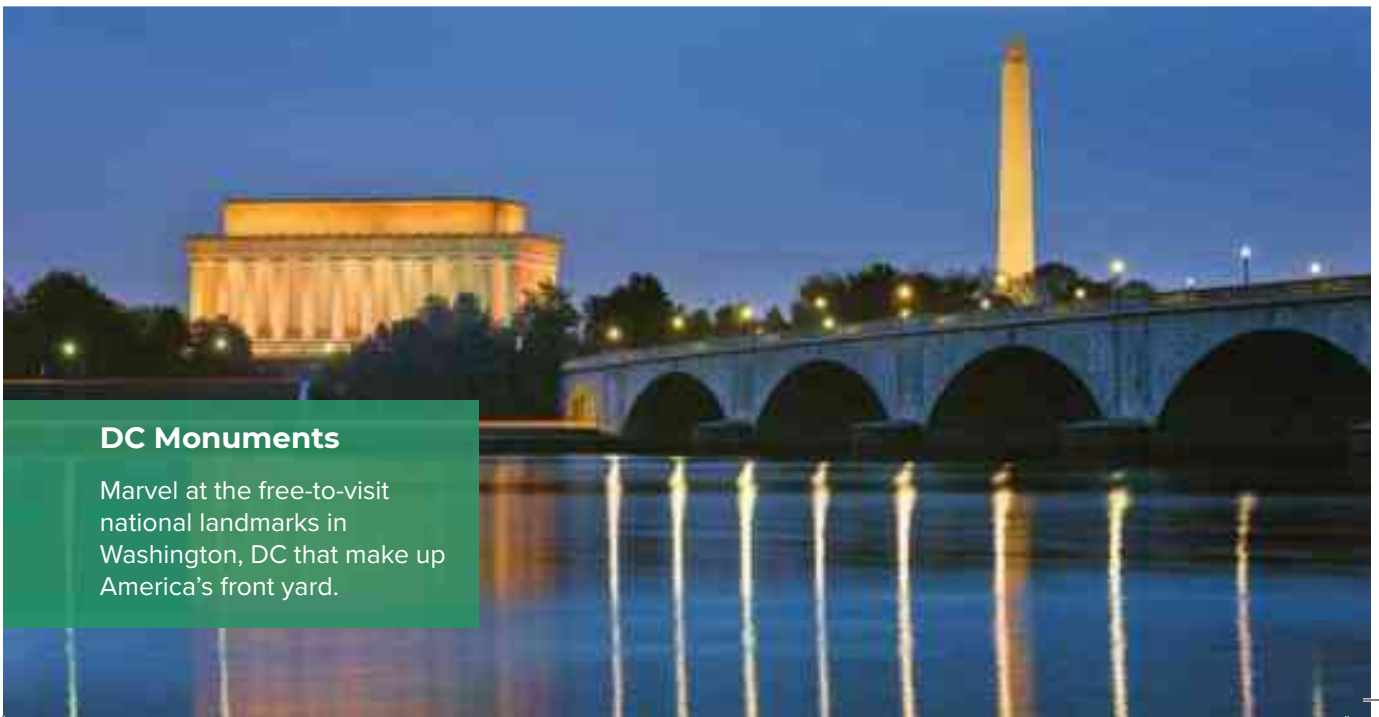

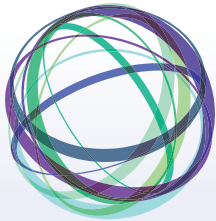

I refer to your letter dated 1 November 2019 which is highly appreciated. In this regard I also would like to express appreciation to the representatives of Ukraine for their participation in the 36th session of the Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting (ISAR), held at the Palais des Nations in Geneva from 31 October to 1 November 2019, including the following experts: President of the State Educational and Scientific Institution “Academy of Financial Management” (SESE “Academy of Financial Management”) Tetiana Iefymenko and Deputy Director of the Financial Research Institute (FRI) of the SESE “Academy of Financial Management” Liudmyla Lovinska for a productive cooperation in the areas of financial reporting harmonization and enhancing the comparability of companies’ reporting on their contribution towards the attainment of Sustainable Development Goals. On this opportunity I would like to underline the contribution of the SESE experts made over the recent years within the ISAR agenda towards the harmonization of enterprise accounting and reporting, including in the context of the EU integration processes taking place in Ukraine which require accounting and reporting systems’ reforming and further implementation of the best practices of non-financial reporting on attaining the Sustainable Development Goals.

Also, in the context of the above, I would like to stress that the research on “Institutional Framework for the Development of Non-Financial Reporting in Ukraine” that you mentioned in your letter is highly relevant and important for the attainment of SDG 12 “Responsible consumption and production”, in particular for the countries’ reporting on the SDG indicator 12.6.1 “Number of companies publishing sustainability reports” not only for Ukraine, but also at a global level. The implementation of the Concept for the Development of Non-Financial Reporting in Ukraine will facilitate addressing the issues of non-financial and sustainability reporting including such as lack of coordination, data sharing and cooperation between entities preparing, processing and using the non-financial reporting, and reporting by entities on the SDG related performance. Findings of research in these areas would also add value and will be practically useful for the work of UNCTAD aimed to enhance quality, comparability and consistency of sustainability and non-financial reporting in member States.

We look forward to our further cooperation with the SESE “Academy of Financial Management”.
